If possible invite all of them for the **Emmaus Word Sharing** Day in your Somudai)

(Keep on the table one white dress, book and pen, a Cross and a Stole)

INTRODUCTION

Leader: During this month of September, we remember and pray for all our Mothers, Teachers, and also for Priestly and Religious Vocations. Let us remember our own mothers, who are also our teachers, and vocation promoters in the family.



Mother: The one who brings the child into this world prepares and the child to know and face the World. The first catechist who teaches the child to love God and to pray and fills them with virtues.



Teacher: The one who nurtures the child with the wisdom and knowledge of the world and prepares him/her for a future career and also to bravely face the challenges of the world



Priests and Religious: The ones who catechize the child, and brings him/her closer to the Eternal God, Our Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The priest/religious prepares the child to say YES to God and His mission and NO to satan and his evil work. They play a threefold role of Christ, to

carry God's Mission in this World.

So let us remember all our mothers, teachers, and Priests/Religious who have touched our lives with love, care and faith.

Leader: Ask the children or youth gathered for Somudai

Let us reflect the Word of God on Mothers: Mt 12: 46-50

Let us pause ...and reflect silently for a minute...



Reflect these biblical quotes also: Is 66:13 "As one whom his mother comforts, so I will comfort you." Isaiah 49:15: "Can a mother forget her nursing child? Can she feel no love for the child she has borne?" Proverbs 31:25: "She is clothed with strength and dignity; she can laugh at the days to come."

Reflection on Mothers in Bible: Ask children to read.



Mother Jochebed: The mother of Moses, Aaron, and Miriam, who showed tremendous faith in God. To avoid the mass slaughter of Hebrew boys, she set her baby adrift in the River Nile, hoping someone would find him and raise him. God so worked that her baby was found by Pharaoh's daughter. Jochebed even became her own son's nurse, ensuring that Israel's great leader would grow up under

the godly influence of his mother during his most formative years.



Mother Hannah: She was cruelly taunted by her husband's other wife. But Hannah never gave up on God. Finally, her heartfelt prayers were answered. She gave birth to a son, Samuel, and then did something entirely selfless to honour her promise to God. God favoured Hannah with five more children, bringing great blessings to her life



Mother Mary: Was the most honoured mother in the Bible, the human Mother of Jesus, who saved the world from its sins. Although she was only a young, humble peasant, Mary accepted God's will for her life. Mary suffered enormous shame and pain, yet never doubted her Son for a moment. Mary stands as highly favoured by God, a shining example of obedience and submission to the Father's will.

Learning: Mothers are faithful, trustworthy, protectors, sacrificing, prayerful, submissive, obedient, and live an exemplary life.

Leader: Invite all the mothers in front and give a candle in their hand and ask all those gathered to extend their hands towards them and to pray for them.

Prayer for Mothers

Heavenly Father, I lift up to you today all our mothers. Bless them with strength to continue to care for their children, with the same boldness and selflessness Mother Mary showed Jesus. Help our mothers to feel our gratitude and truly know their hand in our lives. May they always live a joyful and healthy life.

Second: Let us reflect the Word of God on Teachers: Lk 6: 37-40



Reflect on Biblical quotes: A faithful teacher has a strong love for God, His holy Word and the Lord's Church (1 Cor. 13:4-8a).

Devotion: Good teachers feel devoted to the task of teaching and to those whom they teach (2 Cor. 12:15)

Reflect Teachers in the Bible:

1. **Daniel:** A teacher of wisdom and knowledge, who helped Susan from the evils of elders. He also advised the kings and knew the literature of Babylonians, and also interpreted the dreams and visions of Kings and his people.



2. **Paul:** Paul was a teacher who knew his audience. For instance, he would adjust his approach depending whether he was teaching Jews or Gentiles. At Antioch of Pisidia, Paul preached at the local synagogue to those who were generally familiar with scriptural stories and the doctrine of a Messiah.



3. **Priscilla:** who, alongside her husband Aquila, taught the evangelist Apollos, correcting his understanding of the Gospel and empowering him for ministry.



Learning: teachers are with vision, full of wisdom, knowledgeable, adjustable, understanding, mentors, guides.

Leader: Kindly invite all the teachers and give a candle in their hand and ask those gathered to extend their hands over them and to pray for them.

Prayer for the Teachers

God of Mercy, sustain teachers who give everything they have. Strengthen teachers who assume the blame for so many problems beyond their control. Help exhausted teachers rest. God of strength, encourage teacher to care and inspire them to nourish.

Reflect Biblical Quotes:

1 Pet 2:2-10 "Come to him...let yourselves be built...to be a holy priesthood." Heb 4:12-16 Jesus, the compassionate high priest

Reflect on the Priests and Religious life in the Bible



1.**Priests Aaron:** The ancestor of all priests; he was appointed to this role by God. Other notable high priests in the Bible include Aaron's son Eleazar, Eleazar's son Phinehas, Eli, and Zadok, offered Sacrifice in name of the people.



2. **Prophet Jonah:** In Jonah, we see the worst parts of ourselves magnified, which should generate humility and gratitude that God does love his enemies and puts up with the Jonah in all of us. This strange story becomes a message of good news about the wideness of God's love, which ought to challenge us to the core.



3. King Solomon: is known for being the king of Israel who built the first Temple in Jerusalem. He was also the second (after his father, David) and last king of a unified Israel, which was at the height of its power during his reign. He is known for stories told in the Bible about his wisdom.

Learning: Anointed by God, consecrated, blessed, advisors, disciples, humble, unifying force, mediators, mentors.

Leader: Invite all the Priests and Religious, give a candle in their hand and ask those gathered to extend their hands over them and to pray for them.

Prayer for Priests and Religious

O Jesus, our great High Priest, hear my humble prayers on behalf of your Priests and Religious. Give them a deep faith, a bright and firm hope and a burning love which will ever increase in the course of their spiritual life. In their loneliness, comfort them. In their sorrows, strengthen them, that they may be a living example of humility, forgiveness and service.

We also pray for more vocations, that the children may listen and respond to God's call.

Hymn: Here I am Lord....(N-29 With joyful Lips)

Let us now offer all our Mothers, Teachers, Priests and Religious men and woman and Seminarians to God, and ask the Lord to grant them good health, wisdom and healing to carry on God's Mission, with care and compassion and inspire more vocations for good Christian life.

Application in Life

- 2. Appreciate and acknowledge our teachers contribution in our life....let us call him/her and say 'Thank you teacher'.
- 3. Appreciate and acknowledge all the spiritual support and prayers offered for us by Priests and Religious and say thank you to them
- 4. Let us say something positive about them all, and stop being negative, critical and rude.
- 5. Pray for the Seminarians from your somudai who are preparing themselves for their priestly life.
- 6. Pray for Vocations in our families and Somudai every time we meet in Prayer. Support children / youth who show an inclination towards priestly / religious life and pray for them that they may live a life of virtue and prayer.
